The Bodhananda Seva Society was registered as a charitable organisation on 11th July 1990. The office and ashram of BSS called the Bodhananda Kendram, is situated on the banks of river Karamana, in the holy town of Kalady, in Thiruvananthapuram. The Ashram activities started in the late eighties with regular classes and satsangs organised by a disciple of Swami Bodhananda, Ma Ananda Chinmayi, a reputed headmistress loved by the local community for her social commitments.

Subsequently, a three storied building was constructed in the Ashram premises with a spacious auditorium in the ground floor and residential rooms in the second and third floors. The Ashram also has a conference hall with stateof-the-art amenities and a dining hall. On the eastern side of the ashram, facing the Karamana river stands a temple dedicated to the presiding deity Sidhi Vinayaka.

The temple, and the building with all amenities, which exist today in Bodhananda Kendram, were all financed by a unique project, envisioned by Swami Bodhananda, called "Siddhi Vinayaka Dharma Kalasa" and implemented by his disciples over a period of fifteen years. This project, which continues, is founded on the philosophy of microcharity combined with the spiritual benefits of chanting Ganesa Gayatri mantra.
