

WISDOM FROM THE PAST AS A GUIDELINE FOR THE FUTURE



GOAL REALISATION



WISDOM


Wisdom means drawing the line, and this only the individual can do, to draw the line between freedom and discipline, and attain optimal self-unfoldment.
